

PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION

Pursuant to Article 13(1), (2) and (3) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation, GDPR), I hereby inform you that:

1. The Controller of your personal data is Fiorentini Polska Sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Poznań, ul. Kamiennogórska 22, entered in the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register kept by the District Court Poznań - Nowe Miasto I Wilda in Poznań, 7th Commercial Division of the National Court Register under KRS number 0000015643, NIP (Tax Id. Number): 7772516500, REGON (National Business Registry Number): 639795105, share capital PLN 50,000.00. Contact details: e-mail: biuro@fiorenini.com, tel. +48 61 87 00 107.
2. The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is Article 6(1)(a) and Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR. / In addition, your personal data shall be processed under Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR, i.e. for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the Controller.
3. Your personal data shall be processed for the performance of the Agreement and to take necessary steps prior to entering into the Agreement.
4. Your data may be made available within the Pietro Fiorentini Group, to IT system and IT service providers, and entities providing services to the Controller necessary for the performance of the Agreement, including legal and accounting services, or other entities authorized by law. Your personal data shall not be transferred to any data recipients.
5. Your data shall be stored for no longer than is necessary, i.e. for the period during which claims related to the concluded Agreement may arise.
6. You have the right to access your personal data, the right to rectify it, erase it, and the right to restrict its processing. In addition, you have the right to object to the processing of your personal data and the right to data portability.
7. You have the right to withdraw your consent to the processing of your personal data at any time, however, the withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.
8. You have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority if you consider that the processing of your personal data infringes your rights under Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27, 2016 (GDPR).
9. Providing personal data is not mandatory, however, failure to provide such data will make it impossible to conclude and perform the Agreement.
10. Due to the fact that your personal data is processed under Article 6(1)(e) of the GDPR (processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the Controller) or Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR (processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the Controller indicated in point 4 above), you have the right to object at any time, on grounds relating to your particular situation, to the processing of your personal data based on the above grounds.
11. Personal data shall not be used for automated decision-making, including profiling.
